"They Never Did Fall Away" *Alma 23-29 pg102-105*

"Do you sometimes wonder whether people can really change? Maybe you worry about whether you can overcome poor choices. If so, the story of the Anti-Nephi-Lehies can help. These people were the sworn enemies of the Nephites. But Ammon and his brethren decided to preach the gospel to them. The Lamanites did change—through the converting power of the Lord.

"They became "distinguished for their zeal towards God" (Alma 27:27). In fact, they "never did fall away" (Alma 23:6). No matter what changes you need, Alma 23-29 can give you hope that, through the atoning power of Jesus Christ, long-lasting change is possible" *CFM-IF*

Alma had unwavering faith that the word of God would have a more powerful effect upon the minds of the people than the sword, or anything else.
