The army of Helaman had some advantages over the Lamanites, that had nothing to do with their numbers or military skill. They chose Helaman, a prophet, to lead them; they had been taught by their mothers that if they did not doubt, God would deliver them; and they had exceeding faith in that which they had been taught. As a result, they were protected by the miraculous power of God. Though all were wounded in battle, there was not one soul of them who did perish. So when life inflicts spiritual wounds on each of us, we can take courage — the message of the Army of Helaman is that there is a just God; and whosoever does not doubt, will be preserved by his marvelous power.
