Nephi's father, Helaman, had urged his sons to "remember, remember": he wanted them to remember their ancestors, remember the words of the prophets, and most of all remember our Redeemer, who is Christ.

It is clear that Nephi did remember, because this is the same message he declared years later with unwearyingness to the people. "How could you have forgotten your God?", he asked.
