This Week: September 7th - 13th:

"Lift Up Your Head and Be of Good Cheer " 3 Nephi 1-7 pg142-145

In some ways, it was an exciting time to be a believer in Jesus Christ. Prophecies were being fulfilled — great signs and miracles among the people indicated that the Savior would soon be born. On the other hand, it was also an anxious time for believers because; in spite of all the miracles, unbelievers insisted that the time was past for the Savior to be born. These people caused "a great uproar throughout the land" and even set a date to kill all the believers if the sign prophesied by Samuel the Lamanite — a night without darkness — did not appear.

In these trying circumstances, the prophet Nephi cried mightily to his God in behalf of his people. The Lord's response is inspiring to anyone who faces persecution or needs to know that light will overcome darkness: "Lift up your head and be of good cheer; . . . I will fulfill all that which I have caused to be spoken by the mouth of my holy prophets"
