"I Am the Law and the Light" 3 Nephi 12-16 pg150-153

"Like Jesus's disciples who gathered at the mount in Galilee, the people who gathered at the temple at Bountiful had lived under the law of Moses. They had followed it because it pointed their souls to Christ, and now Christ stood before them, declaring a higher law. But even those of us who have never lived the law of Moses can recognize that the standard Jesus set for His disciples is a much higher law.

"I would that ye should be perfect," He declared. If this makes you feel inadequate, remember that Jesus also said, "Blessed are the poor in spirit who come unto me, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven. This higher law is an invitation — another way of saying Come unto me and be ye saved. Like the law of Moses, this law points us to Christ — the only One who can save and perfect us.
