"I Am the Law and the Light" 3 Nephi 12-16 pg150-153

Those who gathered at the temple at Bountiful had followed the law of Moses, because it pointed their souls to Christ; and now Christ stood before them, declaring a higher law. But even those of us who have never lived the law of Moses can recognize that the standard Jesus set for His disciples is a much higher law.

I would that ye should be perfect," He declared. If this makes you feel inadequate, remember that Jesus also said, "Blessed are the poor in spirit who come unto me, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven. This higher law is an invitation — another way of saying Come unto me and be ye saved. Like the law of Moses, this law points us to Christ — the only One who can save and perfect us. He said, "Behold, I am the law, and the light. Look unto me, and endure to the end, and ye shall live"

Jesus knew that the people needed time to ponder what He had taught. So promising to return the next day, He dismissed the multitude to their homes to ponder. But no one left. Jesus could sense that they hoped He would tarry a little longer with them.

He had other important things to do, but the opportunity to show compassion does not always come at a convenient time, so Jesus stayed with the people a little longer. What followed was perhaps the most tender example of ministering recorded in all of scripture. Those who were present could only say it was indescribable. Jesus Himself summed up the impromptu spiritual outpouring with these simple words:

"Now behold, my joy is full"
