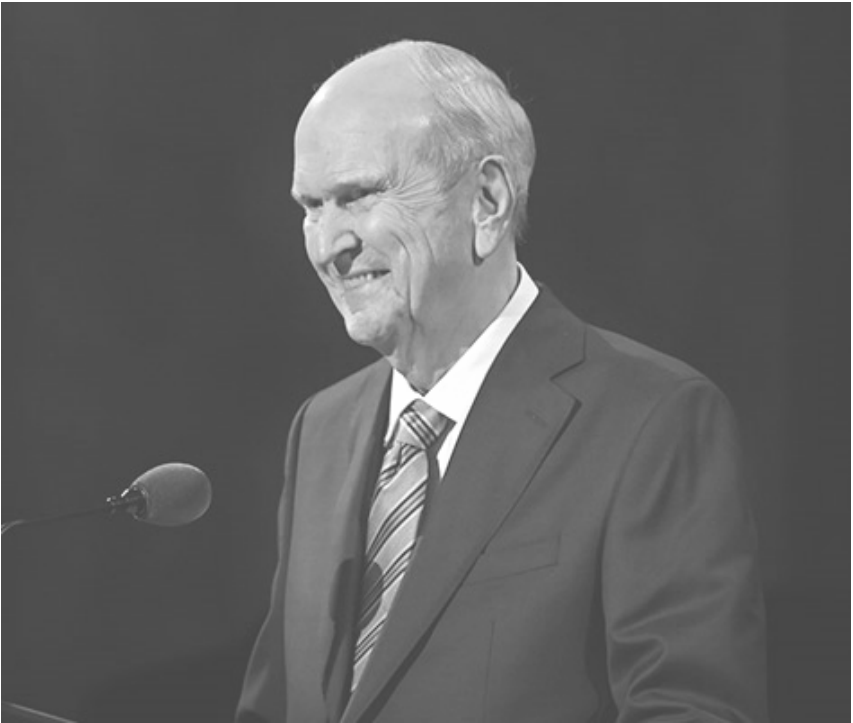

"Ye Are the Children of the Covenant" 3 Nephi 20-26 pg158-161

They were a branch of the tree of Israel, but they were also lost from its body. But when the Savior appeared to the Nephites and Lamanites, He wanted them to know that they were not lost to Him.

"Ye are of the house of Israel," He said, "and ye are of the covenant". He might say something similar to you today, for anyone who is baptized and makes covenants with Him is also of the house of Israel, "of the covenant", no matter who you descend from or where you live.

In other words, when Jesus speaks of the house of Israel, He is talking about you. The instruction to bless "all the kindreds of the earth" is for you. The invitation to "awake again, and put on thy strength" is for you. And His precious promise, "My kindness shall not depart from thee, neither shall the covenant of my peace be removed," is for you
