
Sunday Services Butterfield Canyon 7th Ward October 18th

"There Could Not Be a Happier People" 3 Nephi 27 - 4 Nephi pg162 - 165

The teachings of Jesus Christ are not just a beautiful philosophy to ponder. They are much more than that — they are meant to change our lives. The forth book of Nephi provides a stunning example of this, illustrating just how thoroughly the Savior's gospel can transform a people.

Following Jesus's brief ministry, centuries of contention between the Nephites and Lamanites came to an end.
