Home Study: Come Follow Me - Book of Mormon. (CFM-IF)

This Week October 26th thru November 1st:

"I Would that I Could Persuade All to Repent" - *Mormon 1-6 pg166 - 169*

Mormon spared us the full account of the awful scene of wickedness and bloodshed that he saw among the Nephites. What he did record in Mormon 1-6, is enough to remind us how far righteous people can fall.

Amid such pervasive wickedness, no one could blame Mormon for becoming weary and even discouraged. Yet through all that he saw and experienced, he never lost his sense of God's great mercy and his conviction that repentance is the way to receive it.

And although Mormon's own people rejected his pleading invitations to repent, he knew that he had a larger audience to persuade. "Behold," he declared, "I write unto all the ends of the earth." In other words, he wrote to *you*.

And his message to you, today, is the same message that could have saved the Nephites in their day: "Believe the gospel of Jesus Christ.... Repent and prepare to stand before the judgment-seat of Christ"
