"By Faith All Things Are Fulfilled" - Ether 12-15 pg182 - 185

Ether's prophecies to the Jaredites were great and marvelous. He foresaw the days of Christ... And he spoke of hope for a better world. But the Jaredites rejected his words, for the same reason people often reject the words of God's servants today — because they see them not.

It takes faith to believe in promises or warnings about things we cannot see, just as it took faith for Ether to prophesy of great and marvelous things to an unbelieving people. It took faith for Moroni to trust that the Lord could take his weakness in writing and turn it into strength.

It is this kind of faith that makes us sure and steadfast, always abounding in good works, being led to glorify God. And it is this kind of faith by which "all things are fulfilled" (Ether 12:3).
