This Week November 30th thru December 6th:

"To Keep Them In the Right Way" - Moroni 1-6 pg186 - 189

After finishing his father's record of the Nephites and abridging the record of the Jaredites, Moroni thought that his record-keeping work was done. What more was there to say about two nations that were utterly destroyed? But Moroni had seen our times, and he was inspired to "write a few more things, that perhaps they may be of worth in some future day".

He knew that widespread apostasy was coming, bringing with it confusion about priesthood ordinances and religion in general. This may be why he gave clarifying details about the sacrament, baptism, conferring the gift of the Holy Ghost, and the blessings of gathering with fellow believers to keep each other in the right way, relying alone upon the merits of Christ, who was the author and the finisher of our faith. Precious insights like these give us reason to be thankful that the Lord preserved Moroni's life so he could write a few more things.
