This Week December 7th to December 13th "May Christ Lift Thee Up" - Moroni 7-9 pg190 - 193

Moroni concluded the record we know today as the Book of Mormon with his own final words. Perhaps Moroni included these messages in the Book of Mormon because he foresaw similarities between the perils of his day and ours. When these words were written, the Nephite people as a whole were tumbling headlong into apostasy.

And yet Mormon still found cause for hope — teaching us that hope does not mean ignoring or being naive about the world's problems; it means having faith in Heavenly Father and Jesus Christ, whose power is greater and more everlasting than those problems. It means "laying hold upon every good thing".
