Home Study: Come Follow Me - Book of Mormon: (CFM-IF)

"Come Unto Christ and Be Perfected in Him" - Moroni 10 pg194 - 197

As you finish reading the Book of Mormon, consider seeking a renewed witness from the Holy Ghost that it is true.

The Book of Mormon opens with Nephi's promise to show us that the tender mercies of the Lord are over all those whom he hath chosen because of their faith. The book closes with a similar message from Moroni as he prepared to seal up the records: he invited us to remember how merciful the Lord hath been. Even if we think only of the many mercies recorded in the Book of Mormon, this gives us a lot to think about. What examples come to your mind?

Perhaps most important, ponder how merciful the Lord hath been to you, for one of the main purposes of the Book of Mormon is to invite each of us to receive God's mercy — an invitation expressed simply in Moroni's farewell words, "Come unto Christ, and be perfected in him".
