Joseph Smith -- History 1: 1-26

The Doctrine and Covenants is a book of answers to prayer. Many of the sacred revelations in this book came in response to questions. So it's appropriate to begin studying the Doctrine and Covenants by considering the question that began the latter-day outpouring of revelation —the one Joseph Smith asked in a grove of trees in 1820.

We too can do what Joseph did. We can ask questions, study the scriptures, ponder, and ultimately ask God. In response to Joseph's prayer, a pillar of light descended from heaven; God the Father and Jesus Christ appeared and answered his questions. Joseph's testimony of that miraculous experience boldly declares that anyone who lacks wisdom might ask of God, and obtain.
