Even though the work of translation was progressing well, the situation in Harmony had become more difficult for Joseph, Emma, and Oliver. Hostility from neighbors was growing. Feeling that Harmony was no longer safe, Oliver reached out to a friend who had expressed interest in Joseph's work: David Whitmer.

David lived with his parents and siblings in Fayette, New York, about 100 miles away. He had met Oliver a year earlier, and Oliver had written him several letters since then, sharing his experiences working with the Prophet.

Neither David nor anyone in his family had ever met Joseph. But when Oliver asked if he and Joseph might move to the Whitmer home to finish translating the Book of Mormon, the Whitmers readily opened their doors. And the Lord had more in store for the Whitmers than simply housing the Prophet. He had some specific instruction for them, found in Doctrine and Covenants 14-17, and in time they were to become one of the foundational families of the Church and witnesses to the unfolding Restoration.
