Doctrine & Covenants 45

We live in perilous times, and that can be troubling. Even Jesus's disciples, when they heard Him prophesy of the calamities that would occur in our day, were troubled. The early Saints in Kirtland, Ohio, were also troubled by the perilous times in which they lived.

Among other things, there were many false reports ...and foolish stories" that were undermining the gospel message .But the Lord's response, then and now, is "be not troubled". Yes, there is wickedness, but there is also evidence that God is hastening His work.

Yes, there are perils predicted to precede the Second Coming, and we should be aware of them. But these aren't just warnings of danger; they are also signs that God's promises are about to be fulfilled. Perhaps this is why Doctrine and Covenants 45 — a revelation that describes many of these signs in detail — was received "to the joy of the Saints".
