Doctrine & Covenants 49-50

The Savior is our "good shepherd". He knows that sometimes sheep wander and that the wilderness has many perils. So He lovingly leads us to the safety of His doctrine. Following Him often means letting go of incorrect ideas or traditions.

This was true for [many] in Ohio who accepted the restored gospel but still held on to some beliefs that just weren't correct. In Doctrine and Covenants 49, the Lord declared truths that corrected previous beliefs about topics such as marriage and the Savior's Second Coming.

The Lord taught them how to discern true manifestations of the Spirit. The Good Shepherd was patient; He knew that these early Saints were — like all of us — "little children" who "must grow in grace and in the knowledge of the truth."
