In June 1831, the Lord organized some of the elders into companion-ships and sent them to Jackson County with this charge: "Preach by the way". Many of the elders did so diligently, but others did not. So when they returned to Kirtland, the Lord said "With some I am not well pleased, for they will not open their mouths, but they hide the talent which I have given unto them because of the fear of man".

Many of us can feel sympathy for these elders — we may also feel hesitant to open our mouths and share the gospel. We too may be impeded by the fear of man; or doubt our abilities. But the Lord "knoweth the weakness of man and how to succor us.

Scattered throughout these revelations are reassurances that can help us overcome fears we might be facing: "I, the Lord, rule in the heavens above." "I am able to make you holy." "All flesh is in mine hand." And "be of good cheer little children; for I am in your midst."
