"No Weapon That is Formed Against You Shall Prosper"

Pg 112 - 115 Doctrine & Covenants 71 - 75

Ever since he was a boy, Joseph Smith faced critics—even enemies as he tried to do God's work. But it must have been particularly heartrending in late 1831, when Ezra Booth began publicly berating the Church, because in this case the critic was a former believer.

Ezra had seen Joseph use God's power to heal a woman. He had been invited to accompany Joseph on the first survey of the land of Zion in Missouri. But had since lost his faith; and in an attempt to discredit the Prophet, published a series of letters in an Ohio newspaper. And his efforts seemed to be working: "unfriendly feelings had developed against the Church" in the area.

What should believers do in a case like that? While there is not one right answer for every situation, it seems that quite often, including in this case in 1831, part of the Lord's answer is to defend the truth and correct falsehoods, by proclaiming the gospel.

Yes, the Lord's work will always have critics, but in the end, no weapon that is formed against it shall prosper.
