When the Lord commanded Moses to build a tabernacle, He told Moses to make all things according to the pattern showed him in the mount. The tabernacle was to be the center of Israel's wilderness camp. God also commanded Solomon to build a temple according to a pattern He revealed.

He commanded Joseph Smith to build temples according to a revealed pattern. The Lord declared, "Let it be built after the manner which I shall show" Like the tabernacle in the wilderness, the temple was meant to be a central feature in Kirtland.
