
Sunday Services Butterfield Canyon 7th Ward September 5th 2021

For the Saints in the 1830s, Independence Missouri was literally the promised land. It was "the center place of Zion — the city of God on earth — which they were making great sacrifices to build. To them, the gathering of Saints there was an exciting and glorious prelude to the Second Coming.

But their neighbors in the area saw things differently. They took issue with the claim that God had given the land to the Saints, and they were uncomfortable with the political, economic, and social consequences of so many people from an unfamiliar religion moving into the area so quickly. Soon concern turned into threats, and threats turned into persecution and violence..... Joseph Smith was over 800 miles away in Kirtland, and this news took weeks to reach him.

But the Lord knew what was happening, and He revealed to His Prophet principles of peace and encouragement that would comfort the Saints — principles that can also help us when we face persecution, when our righteous desires go unfulfilled, or when we need a reminder that our daily afflictions will eventually work together for our good.
