Come Follow Me - Doctrine and Covenants September 20-26th

"To Have the Heavens Opened" *pg 162; D&C 106-108*

At first glance, Doctrine and Covenants 107 might seem to be only about organizing priesthood offices into a leadership structure for the Lord's Church. Indeed, by the time this revelation was published, Church membership was already outgrowing the capacity of the few leaders it had in place. So outlining the roles and responsibilities of the First Presidency, the Quorum of the Twelve, the Seventy, bishops, and quorum presidencies was surely needed and helpful.

But there's so much more to the divine instruction in section 107 than just how to organize priesthood offices and quorums. Here the Lord teaches us about an ancient priesthood order that was instituted in the days of Adam. Its purpose from the beginning has been to make it possible for God's children — including you — to receive the saving ordinances of the gospel and enjoy all the spiritual blessings of the church — to have the privilege of receiving the mysteries of the kingdom of heaven and to have the heavens opened unto them.
