"The Fall of Adam and Eve" page 11 *Genesis 3-4; Moses 4 - 5*

At first, the story of the Fall of Adam and Eve might seem like a tragedy. Adam and Eve were cast out of the beautiful Garden of Eden. They were thrown into a world where pain, sorrow, and death are ever present. And they were separated from their Heavenly Father.

But because of the truths restored through the Prophet Joseph Smith in the book of Moses, we know that the story of Adam and Eve is actually one of hope -- and an essential part of God's plan for His children.

The Garden of Eden was beautiful. But Adam and Eve needed something more than just beautiful surroundings. They needed —as do we all —an opportunity to grow. Leaving the Garden of Eden, and their Father, was a necessary first step toward eventually becoming like Him.

That meant facing opposition, making mistakes, learning to repent, and trusting the Savior, whose Atonement makes possible progression and the joy of our redemption. So when you read about the Fall of Adam and Eve, focus not on the seeming tragedy but on the possibilities —not on paradise lost, but on the glory their choice allows us to receive *CFM-IF*.
