Throughout history, people have tried to achieve what Enoch and his people accomplished: building an ideal society where there is no poverty or violence.

As God's people, we share this desire. We call it building Zion, and it includes in addition to caring for the poor and promoting peace; making covenants, dwelling together in righteousness, and becoming one with each other and with Jesus Christ, the King of Zion.

Because the work of establishing Zion continues in our day, it's helpful to ask, How did Enoch and his people do it? How did they become of one heart and one mind, despite the wickedness around them? Among the many details Moses Ch7 gives us about Zion, a particularly valuable one for Latter-day Saints might be this: Zion is not just a city - it is a condition of the heart and spirit. Zion, as the Lord has taught, is the pure in heart. So perhaps the best way to build Zion is to start in our own hearts and homes.
