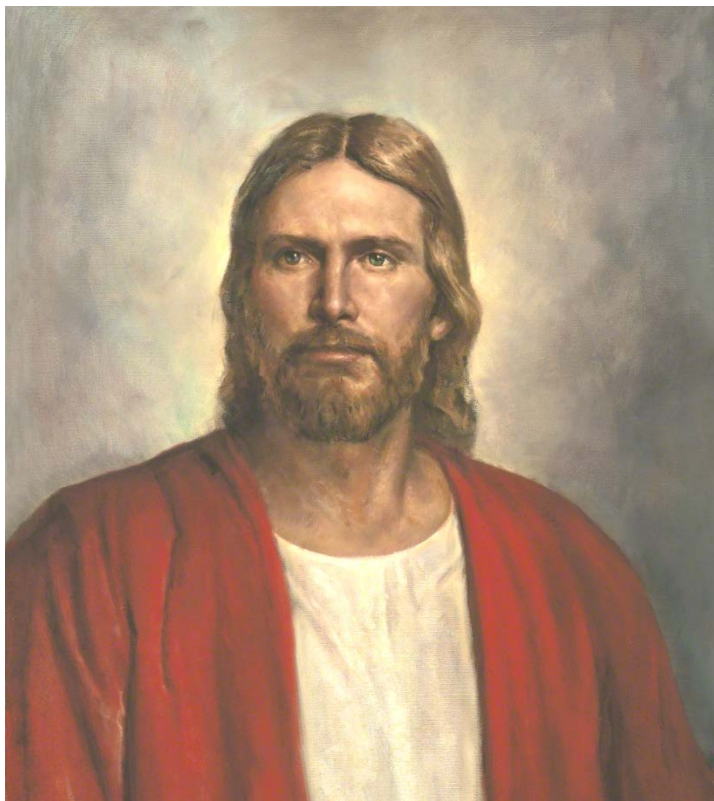

Genesis 12-17; Abraham 1-2

Because of the covenant God made with him, Abraham has been called "the father of the faithful" and "the Friend of God". Millions today honor him as their direct ancestor, and others have been adopted into his family through conversion to the gospel of Jesus Christ.

Yet Abraham himself came from a troubled family. His father, who had abandoned the true worship of God, tried to have Abraham sacrificed to false gods. In spite of this, Abraham's desire was "to be a greater follower of righteousness"; and the account of his life shows that God honored his desire. Abraham's life stands as a testimony that no matter what a person's family history has been, the future can be filled with hope.
