Plague after plague afflicted Egypt, but Pharaoh still refused to release the Israelites. And yet God continued to demonstrate His power and give Pharaoh opportunities to accept "that I am the Lord" and "there is none like me in all the earth". Meanwhile, Moses and the Israelites must have watched with awe at these manifestations of God's power in their behalf.

Surely these continued signs confirmed their faith in God and strengthened their willingness to follow God's prophet. Then, after nine terrible plagues had failed to free the Israelites, it was the tenth plague — the death of the firstborn, including Pharaoh's first-born — that finally ended the captivity. This seems fitting because in every case of spiritual captivity, there truly is only one way to escape. No matter what else we may have tried in the past, it is with us as it was with the children of Israel. It is only the sacrifice of Jesus Christ, the Firstborn - the blood of the Lamb without blemish - that saves.
