"My Presence Shall go With Thee" pg 75; Exodus 25; 31-34

There was reason to be hopeful that the children of Israel would remain true to God after He revealed His law to them. Even though they had murmured and wavered in the past....., they made this covenant: "All that the Lord hath said will we do, and be obedient." God then called Moses onto the mountain, telling him to build a tabernacle so "that I may dwell among them"

But while Moses was at the top of the mountain learning how the Israelites could have God's presence among them, the Israelites were at the bottom of the mountain making a golden idol. They had just promised to "have no other gods", yet they turned aside quickly. It was a surprising turn, but we know from experience that faith and commitment can sometimes be overcome by impatience, fear, and doubt. As we seek the Lord's presence in our lives, it is encouraging to know that the Lord did not give up on ancient Israel; and He will not give up on us — for He is merciful and gracious, longsuffering, and abundant in goodness and truth .
