Even on foot, it would not take 40 years to travel from the wilderness of Sinai to the promised land. But that is how long the children of Israel needed. Not to cover the geographical distance, but to cover the spiritual distance; the distance between who they were and who the Lord needed them to become, as His covenant people.

The book of Numbers describes some of what happened during those 40 years, including lessons the children of Israel needed to learn before entering the promised land. They learned about being faithful to the Lord's chosen servants. They learned about trusting the Lord's power, even when the future seems hopeless. And they learned that being faithless brings spiritual harm, but that they could repent and look to the Savior for healing.

We are all like the Israelites in some ways. We all know what it is like to be in a spiritual wilderness, and the same lessons they learned can help us prepare to enter our own promised land: eternal life - with our Heavenly Father.
