"The Lord Raised Up a Deliverer" page 101; Judges 2-4: 6-8: 13-16

We all know what it's like to make a mistake, feel bad about it, and then repent and resolve to change our ways. But sometimes we forget our earlier resolve, and make the mistake again.

This tragic pattern is typical of the Israelite experience as described in the book of Judges. Influenced by the beliefs and worship practices of the Canaanites — whom they were supposed to drive out of the land — the Israelites broke their covenants with the Lord and turned away from worshipping Him; losing His protection and falling into captivity.

Yet each time this happened, the Lord gave them the chance to repent and raised up a deliverer, a military leader called a "judge." Not all of the judges in the book of Judges were righteous, but some of them exercised great faith in delivering the children of Israel and restoring them to their covenant relationship with the Lord. These stories remind us that no matter what, Jesus Christ is the Redeemer of Israel, and is always willing to deliver us and welcome us back to Him Cfm-if
