Word of Jesus's healing miracles was spreading quickly. Multitudes followed Him, hoping for relief from their sicknesses. But when the Savior looked upon the multitudes, He saw more than their physical ailments. Filled with compassion, He saw "sheep having no shepherd" (Matthew 9:36). "The harvest truly is plenteous," He observed, "but the labourers are few" (Matthew 9:37).
