Family History Corner

Ordinances Ready—There are many ways to find your own family names to take to the temple. The easiest, that usually doesn't involve any research, is to use *Ordinances Ready*. This will describe how to do it on your computer at home. Later, we'll show you how to use *Ordinances Ready* on your phone. The following "roadmap" of clicks is like a street by street description of how to get to the nearest temple. However, once you have driven it you should be able to easily find your way ever after!

How It Works—First, log on to either your FamilySearch Home Page or your Family Tree. Click on the "Temple" from the menu at the top near the FamilySearch logo. From the dropdown menu click "Ordinances Ready". On the Ordinances Ready page, click the "Type" of ordinance you want to do, select the name[s] in the checkbox, scroll to the bottom right to click "Take to the Temple" and then print your card[s]...it's that easy!

John 7 - 10

Although Jesus Christ came to bring "peace [and] good will toward men" (Luke 2:14), there was "a division among the people because of him" (John 7:43). People who witnessed the same events came to very different conclusions about who Jesus was. Some concluded, "He is a good man," while others said, "He deceiveth the people" (John 7:12). When He healed a blind man on the Sabbath, some insisted, "This man is not of God, because he keepeth not the sabbath day," while others asked, "How can a man that is a sinner do such miracles?" (John 9:16). Yet despite all the confusion, those who searched for truth recognized the power in His words, for "never man spake like this man" (John 7:46). When the Jews asked Jesus to "tell us plainly" whether he was the Christ, He revealed a principle that can help us distinguish truth from error: "My sheep hear my voice," He said, "and I know them, and they follow me" (John 10:24, 27).
