Family History Corner

Ordinances Ready—There are many ways to find your own family names to take to the temple. The easiest, that usually doesn't involve any research, is to use *Ordinances Ready*. This will describe how to do it on your computer at home. Later, we'll show you how to use *Ordinances Ready* on your phone. The following "roadmap" of clicks is like a street by street description of how to get to the nearest temple. However, once you have driven it you should be able to easily find your way ever after!

How It Works—First, log on to either your FamilySearch Home Page or your Family Tree. Click on the "Temple" from the menu at the top near the FamilySearch logo. From the dropdown menu click "Ordinances Ready". On the Ordinances Ready page, click the "Type" of ordinance you want to do, select the name[s] in the checkbox, scroll to the bottom right to click "Take to the Temple" and then print your card[s]...it's that easy!

“REJOICE WITH ME; FOR I HAVE FOUND MY SHEEP WHICH WAS LOST”

Luke 12 - 17; John 11

In most situations, 99 out of 100 would be considered excellent—but not when such numbers stand for beloved children of God (see Doctrine and Covenants 18:10). In that case, even one soul merits a thorough, desperate search “until [we] find it” (Luke 15:4), as the Savior taught in the parable of the lost sheep. Then the rejoicing can begin, for “joy shall be in heaven over one sinner that repenteth, more than over ninety and nine just persons, which need no repentance” (Luke 15:7). If that seems unfair, it’s helpful to remember that, in truth, there are none who “need no repentance.” We all need rescuing. And we all can participate in the rescue, rejoicing together over every soul who is saved (see Doctrine and Covenants 18:15–16).
