Family History Corner

Ordinances Ready—There are many ways to find your own family names to take to the temple. The easiest, that usually doesn't involve any research, is to use *Ordinances Ready*. This will describe how to do it on your computer at home. Later, we'll show you how to use *Ordinances Ready* on your phone. The following “roadmap” of clicks is like a street by street description of how to get to the nearest temple. However, once you have driven it you should be able to easily find your way ever after!

How It Works—First, log on to either your FamilySearch Home Page or your Family Tree. Click on the “Temple” from the menu at the top near the FamilySearch logo. From the dropdown menu click “Ordinances Ready”. On the Ordinances Ready page, click the “Type” of ordinance you want to do, select the name[s] in the checkbox, scroll to the bottom right to click “Take to the Temple” and then print your card[s]...it's that easy!

Matthew 19 - 20; Mark 10; Luke 18

If you had the opportunity to ask the Savior a question, what would it be? When a certain rich young man met the Savior for the first time, he asked, "What good thing shall I do, that I may have eternal life?" (Matthew 19:16). The Savior's response showed both appreciation for the good things the young man had already done and loving encouragement to do more. When we ponder the possibility of eternal life, we may similarly wonder if there's more we should be doing. When we ask, in our own way, "What lack I yet?" (Matthew 19:20), the Lord can give us answers that are just as personal as His response to the rich young man. Whatever the Lord asks us to do, acting on His answer will always require that we trust Him more than our own righteousness (see Luke 18:9-14) and that we "receive the kingdom of God as a little child" (Luke 18:17; see also 3 Nephi 9:22).
