

There are many ways to find your own family names to take to the temple. The easiest, that usually doesn't involve any research, is to use <u>ORDINANCES READY</u>

Previously, we described how to use **Ordinances Ready** on your home computer. This will describe how to do it on your smart phone:

To use the **Ordinances Ready** feature on your phone, you first want to download the FamilySearch Tree app (it's free!). Select the "Temple" icon at the bottom and choose **Ordinances Ready**. Choose whatever ordinance you are planning to participate in at the temple.

Short on time? Since most people now watch TV while also looking at their phones, you can utilize **Ordinances Ready** and all the other good things on the FamilySearch Tree app while watching your favorite TV program, Try clicking around the app and get to know your family. If anyone seemed like an unlikely candidate for conversion, it was probably Saul—a Pharisee who had a reputation for persecuting Christians. So when the Lord told a disciple named Ananias to seek out Saul and offer him a blessing, Ananias was understandably hesitant." Lord," he said, "I have heard by many of this man, how much evil he hath done to thy saints" (Acts 9:13). But the Lord knew Saul's heart and his potential, and He had a mission in mind for Saul: "He is a chosen vessel unto me, to bear my name before the Gentiles, and kings, and the children of Israel" (Acts 9:15). So Ananias obeyed, and when he found this former persecutor, he called him "Brother Saul" (Acts 9:17). If Saul could change so completely and Ananias could welcome him so freely, then should we ever consider anyone an unlikely candidate for change—including ourselves?
