Galatians

The gospel of Jesus Christ offers freedom from spiritual bondage. But sometimes people who have experienced the freedom of the gospel turn away from it and “desire again to be in bondage” (Galatians 4:9). This is what some Galatian Saints were doing—they were turning away from the liberty Christ had offered them (see Galatians 1:6). Paul’s Epistle to the Galatians, then, was an urgent call to come back to “the liberty wherewith Christ hath made us free” (Galatians 5:1). This call is one we also need to hear and heed because while circumstances change, the struggle between freedom and bondage is constant. As Paul taught, it’s not enough to be “called unto liberty” (Galatians 5:13); we must also “stand fast” in it (Galatians 5:1) by relying on Christ.

Family History Corner

On national radio recently Terry I Givens [Maxwell Institute, BYU] was asked why members of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints do baptisms for the dead. His reply was: “Latter-day Saints believe that at the last day Heavenly Father will prepare a wedding feast for the entirety of the human family. He wants no empty seats, and we don’t think you *have to come*, but as Latter-day Saints we believe it is our privilege to put everyone’s name on the guest list, and that is what we do when we baptize for the dead. And the radio host said, ‘what an incredibly generous God...how do I get my name on that list?’ Now certainly he was half joking, but I felt he was half serious and recognized in that moment that this is a vision of a God of unprecedented generosity, that this is a Gospel vision of unprecedented ambition.”
